<p>Do we transfer your personal data to third countries?</p>	<p>Your personal data may be transferred outside the European Union - to third countries.</p> <p>Railwaymen uses external providers of various services, e.g. Meta Platforms Ireland Limited (Facebook and subsidiaries) (Meta or Facebook), Google Ireland Limited (Google), Microsoft, Amazon etc.</p> <p>Because of that your personal data may be transferred to the United States of America (USA) in connection with their storage on American servers (in whole or in part). What is important, based on the implementing decision of the European Commission of 10 July 2023, issued on the basis of GDPR, the adequate level of protection of personal data within the EU-US data protection was stated. <p>What are the consequences of not providing your data?</p>	<p>Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to receive electronic commercial information, including our newsletter or free materials.</p>
